

FMS Exam in English: Regulations & Guidelines

Students must decide in the third year whether to take an oral exam in English or another subject. There is no written exam in English. The oral exam counts for 50% of the final mark.

Candidates for the English oral exam can expect the following:

Oral exam

The test lasts **15 minutes** and is **conducted by the candidate's English teacher**, with an external examiner also present. The mark awarded reflects the candidate's performance in terms of both **language and content**.

The candidate is required to choose **2 works of literature in English** to prepare on his/her own for questions and discussion. The works must be by **different authors**. **Neither of the titles chosen may have been read in class or prepared for a presentation or similar.**
